

THE GENERAL POLICY REGARDING THE ASSOCIATION'S DISTRIBUTION OF REMUNERATION TO THE RIGHTSHOLDERS

1. Copydan Writing does not have any funds of its own, see Article 7.1 of the Statutes.
2. After deduction of management costs, the full amount of the remuneration received by Copydan Writing will be paid to Danish and foreign rightsholders.
3. Insofar as possible, the remuneration collected by Copydan Writing as part of its rights management will be distributed individually to the rightsholders. Insofar as possible, the distribution should reflect the actual use of the rightsholders' works in the management areas, see Article 7 of the Statutes.
4. The main rule for the distribution of remuneration between the author members and the publisher members is a 50/50 distribution of the remuneration. This distribution model was first adopted when Copydan Writing ('the Copy Sectors') was established in 1980.
5. The distribution of remuneration to the individual rightsholders takes place not later than six (6) months after the end of the remuneration year for which payment was collected from the user.
6. Individual remuneration of less than DKK 100 is not distributed. If the remuneration for an individual rightsholder does not exceed DKK 100 over a three-year (3-year) period, the amount is not distributed. Upon request from the individual rightsholder, amounts of less than DKK 100 may be distributed.
7. Where it is not possible for Copydan Writing to locate rightsholders of a literary work, Copydan Writing will make selected information available to the public on Copydan Writing's website, www.tekstognode.dk, in accordance with Section 16 of the Danish Collective Management of Copyright Act.
8. Copydan Writing will to the greatest extent possible endeavour to conclude representation and reciprocity agreements with foreign management organisations which may lead to the exchange of mandates and remuneration, see Article 6 of the Statutes.
9. Undistributable funds may be distributed to Copydan Writing's member organisations according to the Policy regarding Undistributable Funds.

10. The general meeting makes decisions on the general policy regarding the distribution of remuneration for the rightsholders, see Section 6(5)(i) of the Danish Collective Management of Copyright Act.
